Play the Game: Context

- Goal is to optimize PD based on what you're dealt; and in later rounds, build your ideal PD
- Use the scenario as the context; then draw content, process, and mindset cards as ways to realize the ideal PD
- Be prepared to present your ideal PD to another group- our scenario was X; here is our PD...

Play the Game: Set-Up

- Each table receives one set of cards containing stacks of:
 - Scenario cards
 - Process cards
 - Content cards
 - Mindset cards
 - Challenge cards
- The five card stacks are on the table
- A table may consist of 3 to 7 people (e.g., a group)
- You play as a group against other groups

Play the Game

- Group selects a <u>scenario card</u> (depending on audience and time, this can be random OR the group selection of the scenario can truly be a selection process.)
- Group takes <u>1 content card</u>, <u>1 process card</u>, and <u>1</u> <u>mindset card</u> (randomly)
- Group develops a professional development program based on cards

Play the Game: Time Passes

 Group takes a <u>challenge card</u> (randomly); needs to adapt scenario

Play the Game: Presentation

Find another group and present your scenario; vote on scenario and get points based on:

- 3 I would attend eagerly
- 2 I would attend if there were no other options
- 1 I would skip
- 0 I would skip and would encourage others to do so
